

Intellicheck Mobilisa's Defense ID[®] System Validates and Authenticates FiXs[®] Certified Credentials and Military Common Access Cards (CAC) to the Source

Defense ID[®] System to Read FiXs and CAC Wirelessly Authenticating to the Source

PORT TOWNSEND, WA – April 20, 2010 -- [Intellicheck Mobilisa, Inc.](#) (NYSE Amex: IDN), a global leader in access control and wireless security systems, has added an additional layer of security by validating Federation for Identity and Cross-Credentialing Systems (FiXs[®]) Certified Identity Credentials. It enhances the Defense ID[®] System, an advanced, mobile, handheld ID card access control product that instantly reads, analyzes and verifies encoded data in contact chips, magnetic stripes, and barcodes on government-issue IDs from across the US and Canada, to read and authenticate FiXs Certified Credentials.

FiXs Certified Credentials are issued to individuals that have undergone thorough background checks. Defense ID will also be able to wirelessly authenticate to the source in real time—that is, to ascertain that the identity credential is not suspended or revoked by pointing directly to the Defense Cross-Credentialing Identification System (DCCIS)/FiXs network.

FiXs certified credential issuers [Operational Research Consultants, Inc. (ORC), a WidePoint company, and Data Systems Analysts (DSA)] are independently audited and fully compliant with the Federal Information Processing Standard (FIPS) 201 and the Personal Identity Verification Part 1 (PIV) Standard.

“This is a large step forward for Intellicheck Mobilisa and Defense ID,” said Dr. Nelson Ludlow, CEO of Intellicheck Mobilisa. “We continue to increase security at our existing installations and provide yet another level of acceptance for our Defense ID product. Further, this strengthens our relationships with existing military bases that use Defense ID, and opens up new business relationships with additional federal agencies that require the ability to read FiXs Certified Credentials and validate PIV credentials as a requirement for purchase. We now can offer the total solution to access control.”

The Federation for Identity and Cross-Credentialing Systems, Inc.[®] is a coalition of commercial companies, government contractors, and not-for-profit organizations that have established and maintain a worldwide, interoperable identity and cross-credentialing network built on security, privacy, trust, standard operating rules, policies and technical standards. The US Department of Defense (DoD) is a participating advisory government organization. The Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) and FiXs have entered into an agreement, known as a Memorandum of Understanding, and have established a secure and interoperable network for authenticating trusted and certified identity credentials between the DoD and FiXs industry partners.

"The Intellicheck Mobilisa's interoperability with the FiXs/DCCIS network provides for a significant deployment and scaling capability for both DoD and Industry." stated Dr. Michael Mestrovich, FiXs' President. "This also marks an important milestone for the adoption of federated identity authentication services. As FiXs and other federations are able to certify and accredit various federated applications and services, communities of interest across the nation will be able to leverage trusted federated identity credentials required for decisions applying to both physical and logical access to resources, data and facilities used for protecting critical infrastructure assets, businesses and the public."
